DELIVERANCE And It Is So!

You Really Need To Know...IT IS SO!

Praise the Lord! Last Sunday morning during our minister's class I was preparing to do a lesson entitled, "John's Disciples". Before the teaching of this lesson I opened up the floor as I normally do for questions and answers from the ministers. This was one of the questions one of the ministers asked, "Could a person be possessed by demons and saved at the same time?"

The first thing that came to my mind was I have answered this question several times and I now realize that people have a problem with the answer. So I decided to go back to scripture and look at it again.

On this coming Sunday our ministers will be in a three-week class and all others who would like to look on. We will be unveiling what goes on in our private deliverance sessions. I will attempt to show you tonight why it is important to get delivered and stay delivered.

Now let's begin the lesson on deliverance. The textbook to use the next three weeks will be Weapons for Warriors.

DEFINITIONS

Merriam-Webster's Collegiate Dictionary

1. **Deliverance** – the act of delivering someone or something, the state of being delivered, liberation, rescue.
2. **Circumcision** – the act of circumcising, a Jewish rite performed on male infants as a sign of inclusion of Jewish religious community.
3. **Liberty** – the quality of state of being free, the power to do as one pleases, freedom from arbitrary or despotic control.

Galatians 5:1-10

- 1 Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage.
- 2 Behold, I Paul say unto you, that if ye be circumcised, Christ shall profit you nothing.
- 3 For I testify again to every man that is circumcised, that he is a debtor to do the whole law.
- 4 Christ is become of no effect unto you, whosoever of you are justified by the law; ye are fallen from grace.
- 5 For we through the Spirit wait for the hope of righteousness by faith.
- 6 For in Jesus Christ neither circumcision availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision; but faith which worketh by love.
- 7 Ye did run well; who did hinder you that ye should not obey the truth?
- 8 This persuasion *cometh* not of him that calleth you.
- 9 A little leaven leaveneth the whole lump.
- 10 I have confidence in you through the Lord, that ye will be none otherwise minded: but he that troubleth you shall bear his judgment, whosoever he be.
