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DEFINITIONS

Subdue:

- 1** : to conquer and bring into subjection : [**VANQUISH**](#)
- 2** : to bring under control especially by an exertion of the will
- 3** : to bring (land) under cultivation
- 4** : to reduce the intensity or degree of : tone down

Embassy:

- 1** : a body of diplomatic representatives; *specifically* : one headed by an ambassador
- 2** : A permanent diplomatic mission. A **diplomatic mission** is a group of people from one [state](#) or an international inter-governmental organization (such as the United Nations) present in another state to represent the sending state/organization in the receiving state.
- 4** : the official residence and offices of an ambassador

Replenish

SCRIPTURAL REFERENCES**Ezekiel 28:13-19**

¹³Thou hast been in Eden the garden of God; every precious stone was thy covering, the sardius, topaz, and the diamond, the beryl, the onyx, and the jasper, the sapphire, the emerald, and the carbuncle, and gold: the workmanship of thy tabrets and of thy pipes was prepared in thee in the day that thou wast created.

¹⁴Thou art the anointed cherub that covereth; and I have set thee so: thou wast upon the holy mountain of God; thou hast walked up and down in the midst of the stones of fire.

¹⁵Thou wast perfect in thy ways from the day that thou wast created, till iniquity was found in thee.

¹⁶By the multitude of thy merchandise they have filled the midst of thee with violence, and thou hast sinned: therefore I will cast thee as profane out of the mountain of God: and I will destroy thee, O covering cherub, from the midst of the stones of fire.

¹⁷Thine heart was lifted up because of thy beauty, thou hast corrupted thy wisdom by reason of thy brightness: I will cast thee to the ground, I will lay thee before kings, that they may behold thee.

¹⁸Thou hast defiled thy sanctuaries by the multitude of thine iniquities, by the iniquity of thy traffick; therefore will I bring forth a fire from the midst of thee, it shall devour thee, and I will bring thee to ashes upon the earth in the sight of all them that behold thee.

¹⁹All they that know thee among the people shall be astonished at thee: thou shalt be a terror, and never shalt thou be any more.

BISHOP'S NOTES

In the instructions that God gives in Mark 6, He says:

1. Take nothing for your journey. This is where our dominion is compromised. When you don't take God at His Word, you wound up bringing your past into your future.
2. Take only your staff: no bread, no bag, no money in your belt. The staff is a symbol of your anointing. God wants you to move with the anointing. He doesn't want you in the pulpit with hunger pains, an agenda, or past hurts. Don't bring the dirt of one situation into a clean house.
3. You don't need the approval of man, apparel, education, encouragement, large crowds, fame, money, or affirmation. You just need your staff. Know that satan will always be after your staff...your anointing.

Unrighteousness- A distant relationship with God.

- Unrighteousness keeps you in the *sense-realm*—you have to feel something before you act on it.
- Gives a sense of inferiority.
- Promotes a sense of imminent failure... a sense of sin-consciousness...a sense of unworthiness.

- Destroys initiative.
- Robs a person of fellowship and communion with God.
- Gives a sense of spiritual failure.

Righteousness is the opposite... You have to believe it before you see it. How do you receive righteousness? You receive righteousness by faith.
