**1 Corinthians 2**

<sup>1</sup>And I, brethren, when I came to you, came not with excellency of speech or of wisdom, declaring unto you the testimony of God.

<sup>2</sup>For I determined not to know any thing among you, save Jesus Christ, and him crucified.

<sup>3</sup>And I was with you in weakness, and in fear, and in much trembling.

<sup>4</sup>And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power:

<sup>5</sup>That your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God.

<sup>6</sup>Howbeit we speak wisdom among them that are perfect: yet not the wisdom of this world, nor of the princes of this world, that come to nought:

<sup>7</sup>But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, even the hidden wisdom, which God ordained before the world unto our glory:

<sup>8</sup>Which none of the princes of this world knew: for had they known it, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory.

<sup>9</sup>But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him.

<sup>10</sup>But God hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God.

<sup>11</sup>For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? even so the things of God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God.

<sup>12</sup>Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God.

<sup>13</sup>Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual.

<sup>14</sup>But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.

<sup>15</sup>But he that is spiritual judgeth all things, yet he himself is judged of no man.

<sup>16</sup>For who hath known the mind of the Lord, that he may instruct him? but we have the mind of Christ.

### **Isaiah 55:6-12**

<sup>6</sup>Seek ye the LORD while he may be found, call ye upon him while he is near:

<sup>7</sup>Let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts: and let him return unto the LORD, and he will have mercy upon him; and to our God, for he will abundantly pardon.

<sup>8</sup>For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, saith the LORD.

<sup>9</sup>For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts.

<sup>10</sup>For as the rain cometh down, and the snow from heaven, and returneth not thither, but watereth the earth, and maketh it bring forth and bud, that it may give seed to the sower, and bread to the eater:

<sup>11</sup>So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it.

<sup>12</sup>For ye shall go out with joy, and be led forth with peace: the mountains and the hills shall break forth before you into singing, and all the trees of the field shall clap their hands.

### **Numbers 23:19-20**

<sup>19</sup>God is not a man, that he should lie; neither the son of man, that he should repent: hath he said, and shall he not do it? or hath he spoken, and shall he not make it good?

<sup>20</sup>Behold, I have received commandment to bless: and he hath blessed; and I cannot reverse it.

### **Gen. 27:33, 37**

#### **The blessing that cannot be reversed—**

<sup>33</sup>And Isaac trembled very exceedingly, and said, Who? where is he that hath taken venison, and brought it me, and I have eaten of all before thou camest, and have blessed him? yea, and he shall be blessed.

<sup>37</sup>And Isaac answered and said unto Esau, Behold, I have made him thy lord, and all his brethren have I given to him for servants; and with corn and wine have I sustained him: and what shall I do now unto thee, my son?

### **Gen. 27:38-40**

#### **The announcing of a destiny—**

<sup>38</sup>And Esau said unto his father, Hast thou but one blessing, my father? bless me, even me also, O my father. And Esau lifted up his voice, and wept.

<sup>39</sup>And Isaac his father answered and said unto him, Behold, thy dwelling shall be the fatness of the earth, and of the dew of heaven from above;

<sup>40</sup>And by thy sword shalt thou live, and shalt serve thy brother; and it shall come to pass when thou shalt have the dominion, that thou shalt break his yoke from off thy neck.

**How to Discern When Individuals Are Operating Contrary to the Will of God:**

1. They become evil in the pursuit of their purpose.
2. They tear down more relationships than they build.
3. The things that they say God told them to do conflict with scripture.
4. The things that God “supposedly” speaks never comes to fruition.
5. They seek ungodly means for fulfillment.
6. They settle for less than what God spoke.
7. They constantly complain about what God has told them to do.
8. They show no signs of faith.
9. They constantly make questionable excuses for the vision not manifesting.
10. Their motives for fulfilling the objective are wrong (i.e. to show off, or to seek revenge)
