PRINCIPLES TO SECURING A BETTER LIFE...

1. Be honest about your flaws and clean up your character.
2. Stop hindering yourself by being fearful of success.
3. Stop making excuses for failure.
4. Set a goal for how much money you want to have saved by the end of the year; then make the necessary steps toward achieving it.
5. Watch what you say. Negative language prolongs your success.
6. Make a list of *realistic*, positive accomplishments that you want to accomplish for the remainder of the year. Each week do something that brings you closer to accomplishing each of them.
7. Let go of the unforgiveness that you are holding against others.
8. Ignoring problems only gives them time to get worse. Confront them now, so that you can have peace of mind later.
9. Stop stressing over debt. Live beneath your means and pay off your creditors, one at a time, until you become debt-free.
10. Challenge yourself by becoming more educated concerning the things that intimidate you the most. For instance, if you don't know how to read, learn. If you have been pretending to be rich, stop the façade and seek the proper counseling on getting out of debt.
