## Summary:

The original earth (Gen. 1:1), the Chaotic earth (Gen 1:2), and the earth restored (Gen 1:3-31).

### Original

- Satan, the anointed cherub that covereth (Ezek. 28:14). He is exalted and has a throne and authority in the original earth. (Isa. 14:13,14)
- Satan rebels in the original earth. (Gen 1:1).
- Satan was deposed and became the prince and power of the air. (John 12:31, 14:30; Eph. 2:2, Eph. 6:11,12)

### Chaotic

- The earth plunged into its chaotic state.
- The trial of satan begins. The earth is restored. (Gen 1:3-31)

### Restored Earth

- Satan incarnates himself in the serpent
- Satan seduces Adam and Eve
- Satan establishes his earthly kingdom
- Adam and Eve are expelled from Eden
- The first death occurs (which is Abel's)
- Noah's flood occurs
- The angels that kept not their first estate are placed in chains under darkness, Tartarus...prison of fallen angels.
- The Tower of Babel is established. (Gen 11:1-9)
- The building of Babel is inspired by satan to establish himself once again as the god of this world.
- Satan is approached by God to try Job. (Job 1:1; Job 2:10)
- Moses is born.
- Pharoah is a type of satan.
- Satan is behind Pharoah's magicians. (Exodus 7:10-13)
- The Day of Christ, Jesus is born.
- Satan re-groups...33-year plot to assassinate Jesus.
- Jesus is assassinated/crucified, but he doesn't stay dead long.
- Three days later, Jesus is resurrected from the dead with keys to hell, death, and the grave. He spends three days in hell to establish His church on earth, the gateway to heaven.
- The keys to the kingdom that He gives to Peter are now revealed in the five-fold ministry, to which Jesus descended into hell to retrieve, led captivity captive and gave gifts to men. And he gave some apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, pastors, and teachers, for the edifying of the body and for the work of the ministry.
- Satan again re-groups, establishing a false church. 1 Tim. 4:1-3 (Many will depart from the faith give into seducing spirits and doctrines of devils).
- The **Satanic Trinity** is revealed: the dragon, the beast, the false prophet. (Rev. 12:7-12) ;
  - The DRAGON, which is the anti-god is a red, seven-headed, ten-horned, winged creature. He has seven crowns. His tail drew a third of the stars in heaven. It's Lucifer, himself.

- The BEAST (Rev. 13) is the anti-christ. He looks like a leopard. He has the feet of a bear, the mouth of a lion, seven heads, ten horns, and seven crowns. The Dragon (the anti-god) gave the BEAST (the anti-christ), his power, his throne, and great authority.
- The FALSE PROPHET is the anti-spirit. He comes out of the earth. He has two horns, like a lamb, but he speaks like a dragon. He executes all of the authority of the beast (the antichrist) to make the inhabitants of the earth worship the beast, (the antichrist).

But the Lord, Himself, shall descend from Heaven with a loud cry, and with the voice of the archangel and the trumpet of God. The dead in Christ shall rise first. Those who are alive will be caught up to meet the Lord in the air, and forever shall we be with the Lord. This is a brief summary of the life and the fall and the eternal judgment of Lucifer and God's commitment to the Saints—the Blood-washed, His chosen people. As He prayed in the Garden, so I remind you: "Father, all you have given into my hands, I have lost none with the exception of Judas, but that was for the fulfilling of the prophecy. This same Jesus, this same God, this same Spirit, who cannot lie, but can only lead you into all Truth has made this Promise: 'Whosoever shall believe in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life, and to those who believeth not shall be dammed and consumed by hell's fire.' It's your choice. Eternal life and eternal damnation are in the power of your tongue. Choose this day, whom ye shall serve, whether God, money, or the devil himself. And always remember, hell was created for the devil and his angels. Don't become a satanic messenger, a priest of the devil's false doctrine, but rather, become a son of God by accepting the finished works of Calvary and worshipping your Creator who is blessed forever. <sup>19</sup>There was a certain rich man, which was clothed in purple and fine linen, and fared sumptuously every day:

<sup>20</sup>And there was a certain beggar named Lazarus, which was laid at his gate, full of sores,

<sup>21</sup>And desiring to be fed with the crumbs which fell from the rich man's table: moreover the dogs came and licked his sores.

<sup>22</sup>And it came to pass, that the beggar died, and was carried by the angels into Abraham's bosom: the rich man also died, and was buried;

<sup>23</sup>And in hell he lift up his eyes, being in torments, and seeth Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom.

<sup>25</sup>But Abraham said, Son, remember that thou in thy lifetime receivedst thy good things, and likewise Lazarus evil things: but now he is comforted, and thou art tormented.

<sup>26</sup>And beside all this, between us and you there is a great gulf fixed: so that they which would pass from hence to you cannot; neither can they pass to us, that would come from thence.

<sup>27</sup>Then he said, I pray thee therefore, father, that thou wouldest send him to my father's house:

<sup>28</sup>For I have five brethren; that he may testify unto them, lest they also come into this place of torment.

<sup>29</sup>Abraham saith unto him, They have Moses and the prophets; let them hear them.

<sup>30</sup>And he said, Nay, father Abraham: but if one went unto them from the dead, they will repent.

<sup>31</sup>And he said unto him, If they hear not Moses and the prophets, neither will they be persuaded, though one rose from the dead.
